

## Orders In Council - Tabled at Open Cabinet Meetings

Orders in Council (OIC) passed by Cabinet, do not have the force of law until approved by the Lieutenant-Governor of British Columbia and in the case of regulations, deposited by the Registrar of Regulations, Ministry of Attorney General. A [complete list of Orders in Council](#) are made available once approved and ordered.

### OIC tabled August 15th, 2001

- Routine, Ministry of Finance: This OIC authorizes the Minister of Finance to borrow \$5.681 billion for: the efficient management of the Consolidated Revenue Fund; investing under section 40 of the Financial Administration Act; and/or lending to government bodies. This is consistent with the borrowing requirements as tabled in the 2001/02 Fiscal Update. [Statute: Financial Administration Act ss. 50, 51, 52, 53, 60, 61 & 65]
- Regulations, Ministry of Forests: This OIC ensures all previous references to the Deputy Minister of Environment, Lands and Parks in the Operational Planning Regulation and the Woodlot Licence Forest Management Regulation now reference the Deputy Minister of Water, Land and Air Protection. As a result, government avoids the possibility of any decisions that are made under these sections of the regulations being declared legally invalid due to a reference to the wrong Deputy Minister.
