

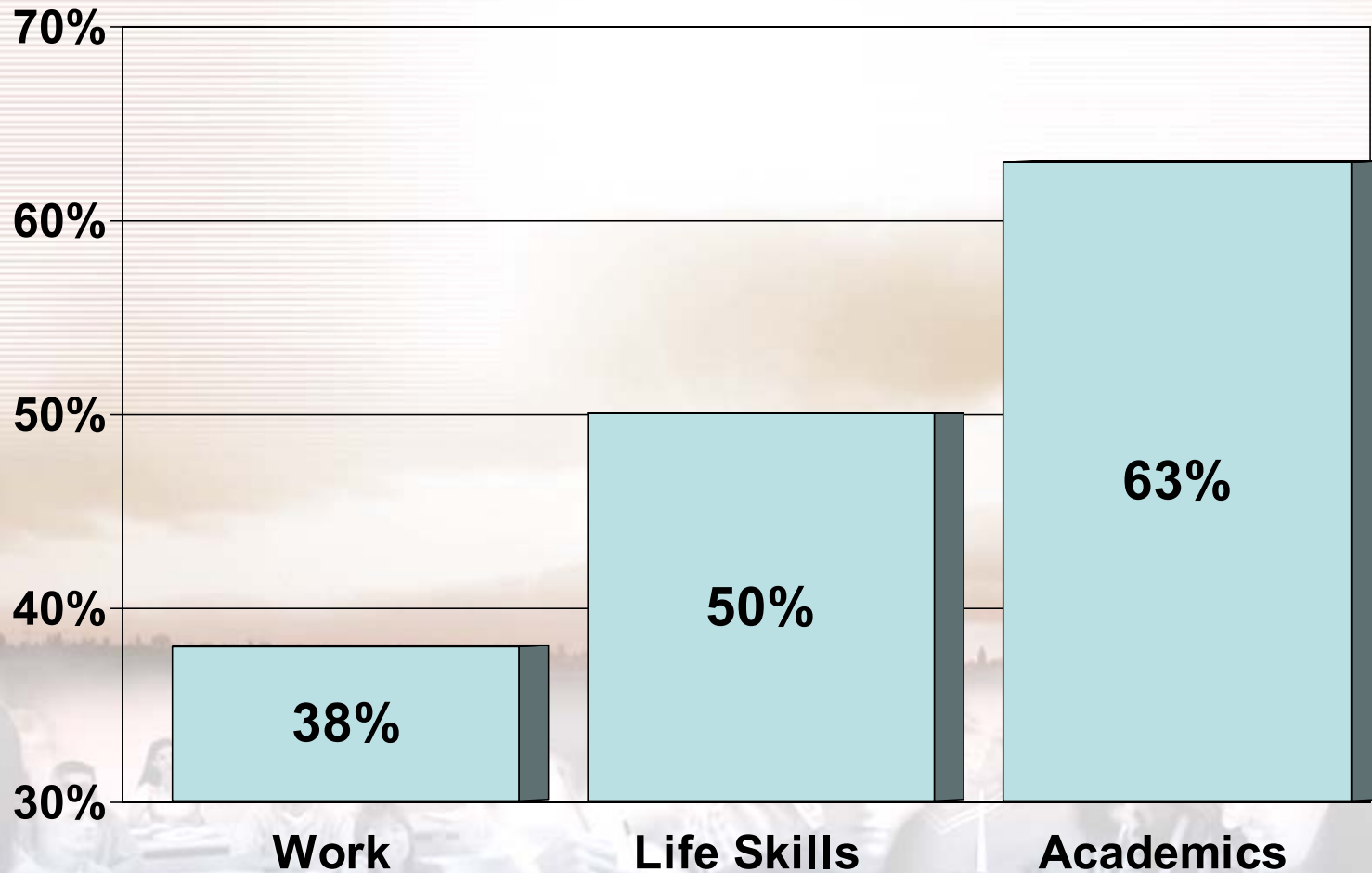

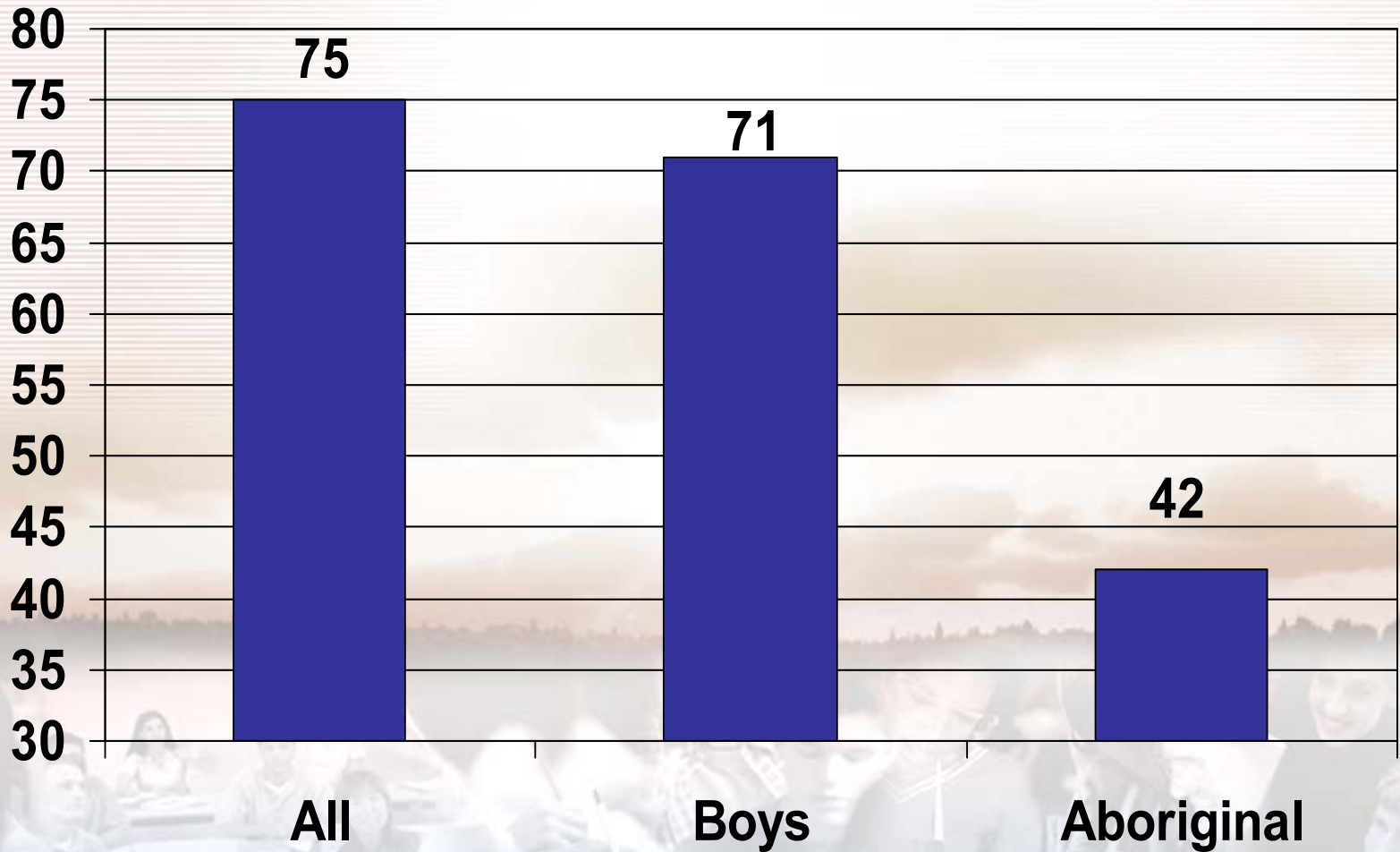
# GRADUATE SATISFACTION

## 2001 Graduates Transition Survey




# GRADUATION RATES

**2000/2001**




# CONSULTATION FINDINGS

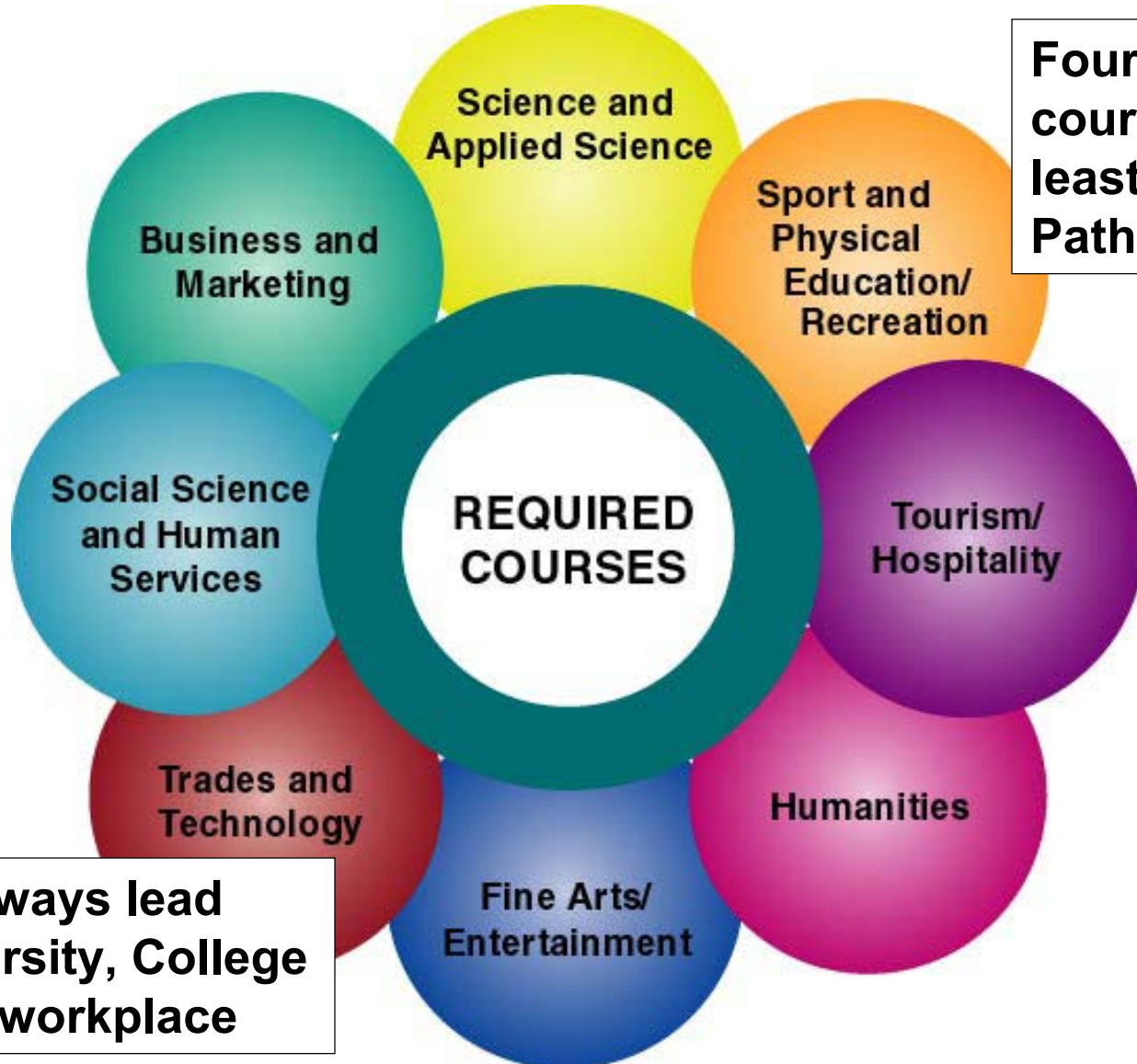
- **Better measure achievement of all graduates in core areas**

# PROPOSED CHANGES

- **21 course-based to 5 comprehensive knowledge-based exams**
  - **Include optional Grade 12 provincial exams**
- **Provide students with focused choice among various pathways**
- **Encourage locally-developed courses**
- **Introduce portfolio assessment**



# PROPOSED CHANGES

- **Include Grade 10 in the Graduation Program**
- **Increase choice and flexibility for students in Grades 10, 11 and 12**
- **Make physical education mandatory until Grade 12**
- **Allow students to receive credit for post-secondary courses**
