<sup>3</sup>Program delivery agreements refer to multiple contracts or operating leases that support program delivery. Examples include contracted residential care, health care services and supports for children with special needs.

<sup>4</sup>Capital development agreements refer to contracts for the construction of single or multiple capital projects, including buildings, roads and information systems.
