PERMIT TO HARVEST OYSTERS FROM VACANT CROWN FORESHORE

THIS IS TO CERTIFY THAT John Doe

of 123 ABC Lane, XYZ City, British Columbia

has made application for a permit to harvest oysters from vacant Crown foreshore and has paid the fee of \$75.00 prescribed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council. Therefore the said John Doe

is hereby permitted, pursuant to Section 9 of the Fisheries Act Regulations, to harvest oysters from the vacant Crown foreshore herein described, and subject also to the permittee paying to the Province of British Columbia a royalty in the amount of \$25.00 per ton for all oysters taken. Permittee and the original permit must be present when harvesting oysters from the following described Crown foreshore: **Atrevida Reef, as outlined on attached chart.**

- 1) Any container holding shellfish must be tagged with the following: the name of the harvester, the DFO statistical area and sub-area, the date of harvest, and the permit number. Failure to comply may result in loss of product.
- 2) All harvesters must have in their possession a valid Fisher Registration Card.
- 3) This permit does not grant permission to harvest from existing leases or from foreshore fronting First Nations Reserves.
- 4) This permit does not allow trespass on upland areas.
- 5) Permit holder is not to block access to upland areas.

Permit Quota 2 tons

This permit becomes effective on the 1st day of August 2001 and expires

on the 4th day of August 2001

NOTE – This licence is not transferable.
