WOMEN IN POLITICS: A BIBLIOGRAPHY

Women have become an increasing presence in Canadian politics since gaining the right to vote in provincial elections in 1916 and federal elections in 1918.¹ As of 2009, women comprised nearly thirty percent of BC's members of the legislative assembly; twenty-two percent of federal members of parliament were women. This bibliography lists library sources examining women's political participation. References are available in the library or through online databases using the links provided.

¹ The 1918 *Women's Franchise Act* granted the federal franchise to women over twenty-one years of age; women over twenty-one began voting in provincial elections following an amendment to the *Provincial Elections Act* in 1916. These acts extended universal voting rights to only British subjects.
