Q1. *Please state your name and present position.*

A. My name is Douglas Little. I am Vice President, Marketing and Trade Policy at Powerex Corp.

Q2. *How long have you held that position?*

A. I have held my present position since October 2002.

Q3. *What were your previous positions with Powerex or BC Hydro?*

A. I joined BC Hydro in 1990 and worked in the rate design, policy development and inter-utility contracts areas. In 1993 I moved to Powerex to head up its regulatory group and was appointed Vice President, Trade Policy and Development in October 1998.

Q4. *What positions did you hold prior to joining BC Hydro and with whom?*

A. Prior to returning to graduate school I worked for three years in the Engineering Department of an insurance risk management consulting firm.

Q5. *What are your professional qualifications?*

A. I have a Bachelor of Applied Science Degree in Civil Engineering and Masters Degree in Business Administration, both from the University of British Columbia.

Q6. *Have you previously testified before this Commission or its predecessors?*

A. Yes. I testified in the BC Hydro Wholesale Transmission Service Application Hearings in 1997, and the WKP 3808/PPA hearing in 1993. I have also testified in regulatory proceedings in Alberta and with the Bonneville Power Administration.

Q7. *What role did you play in the development of this Application?*

A. I was a member of the Oversight Committee responsible for overseeing the development of this Application.

Q8. *Are there sections of the Application for which you assumed particular responsibility?*

A. Yes. I will be speaking to section 3.4 of the Heritage Contract proposal.
