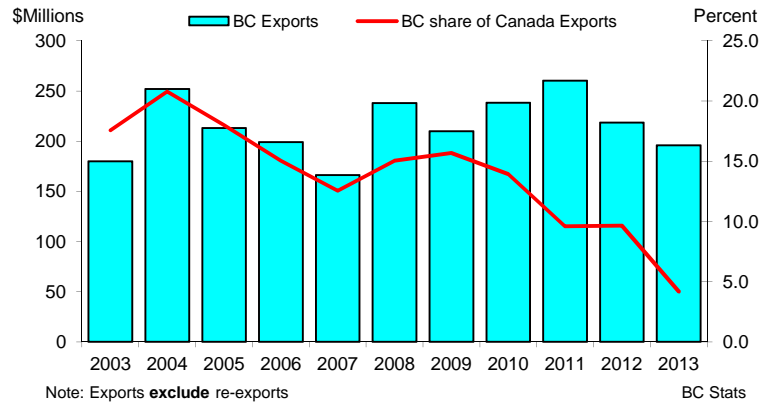

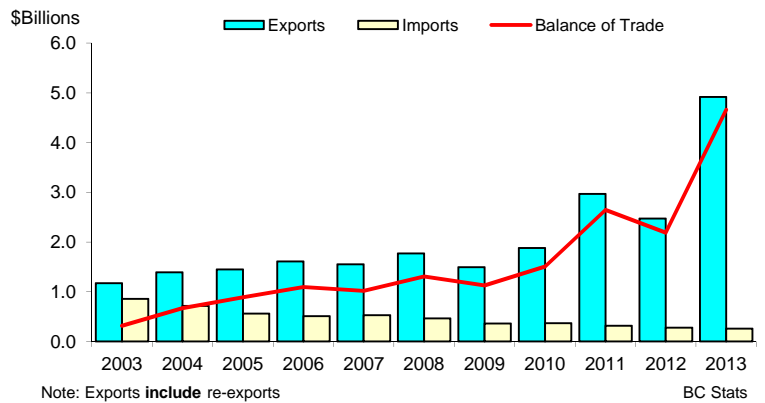
BC Origin Exports to Hong Kong

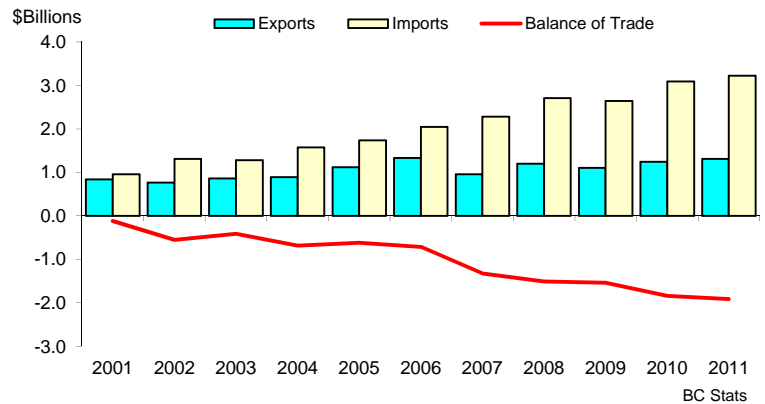
Canada's Balance of Trade in Goods with Hong Kong

How important is Hong Kong to BC and Canada?

Hong Kong ranked #14 as a destination for BC origin exports in 2013 with 0.6% of BC's commodity exports shipped there. It was ranked #6 as a destination for Canadian exports with 1.1% of Canadian goods exports shipped there and #67 as a source of imports into Canada with 0.1% of Canadian imports originating from Hong Kong.

How important is Canada to Hong Kong?

Canada was the source of approximately 0.3% of imports into Hong Kong in 2012. Approximately 0.1% of exports from Hong Kong were destined for Canada in that year.

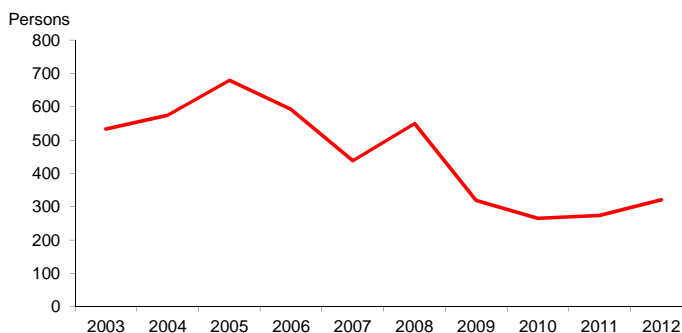
Year-Over-Year % Growth in GDP of Hong Kong

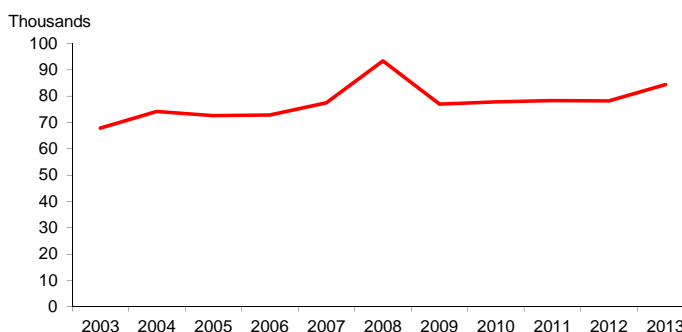
Immigrants to BC from Hong Kong
