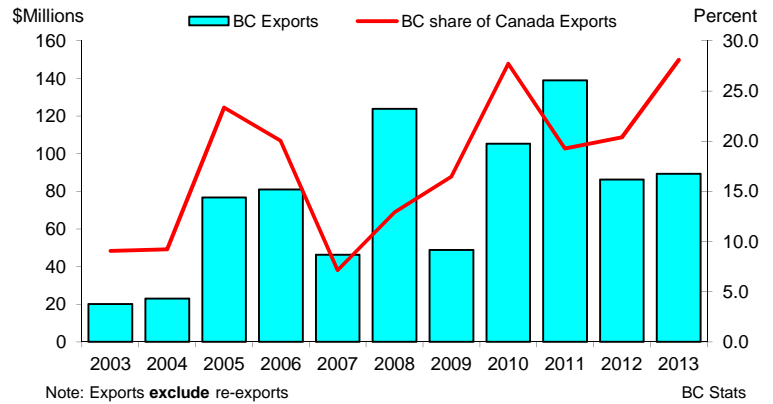

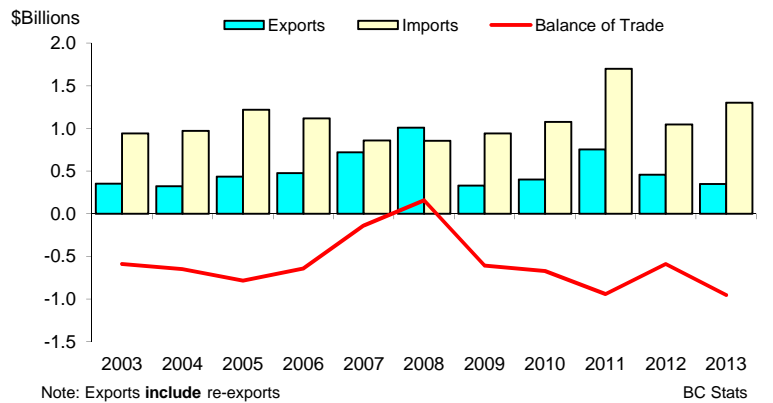

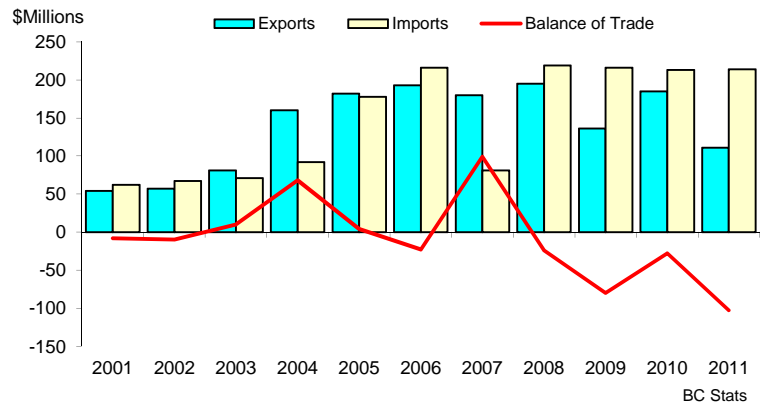
BC Origin Exports to Finland

How important is Finland to BC and Canada?

Finland ranked #21 as a destination for BC origin exports in 2013 with 0.3% of BC's commodity exports shipped there. It was ranked #48 as a destination for Canadian exports with 0.1% of Canadian goods exports shipped there and #36 as a source of imports into Canada with 0.3% of Canadian imports originating from Finland.

How important is Canada to Finland?

Canada was the source of approximately 0.5% of imports into Finland in 2012. Approximately 1.4% of exports from Finland were destined for Canada in that year.

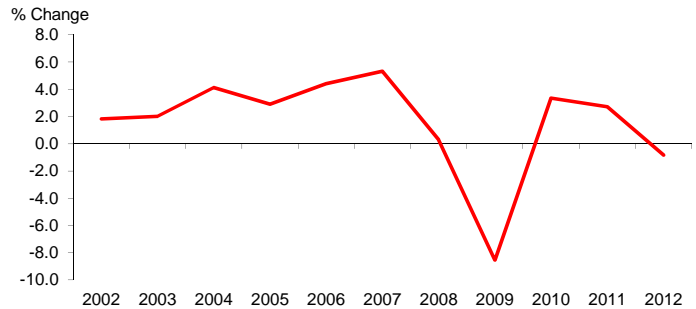

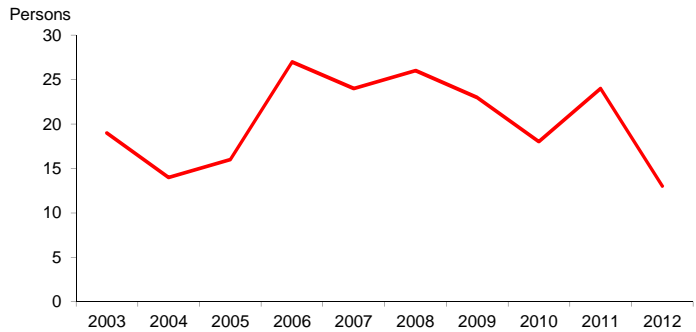
Year-Over-Year % Growth in GDP of Finland

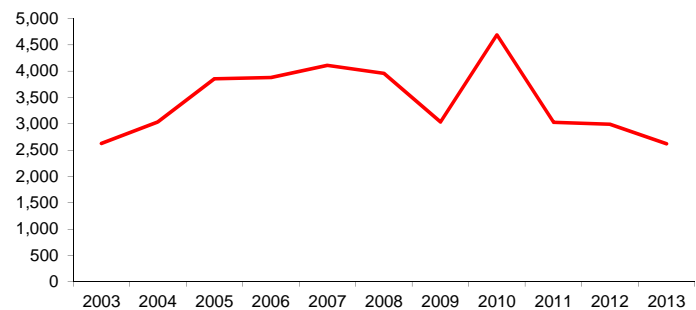
Immigrants to BC from Finland
