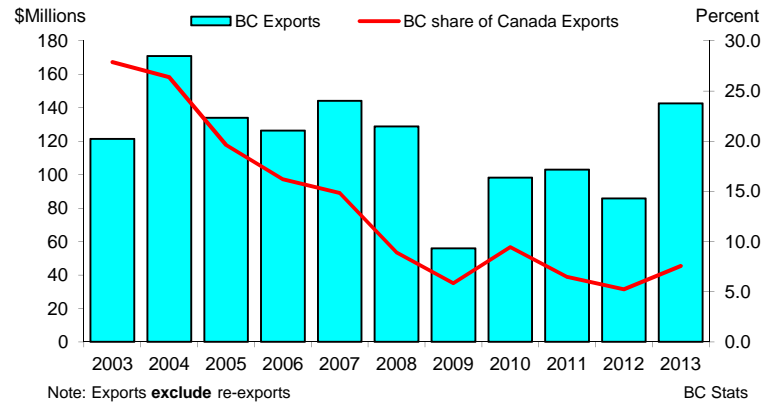

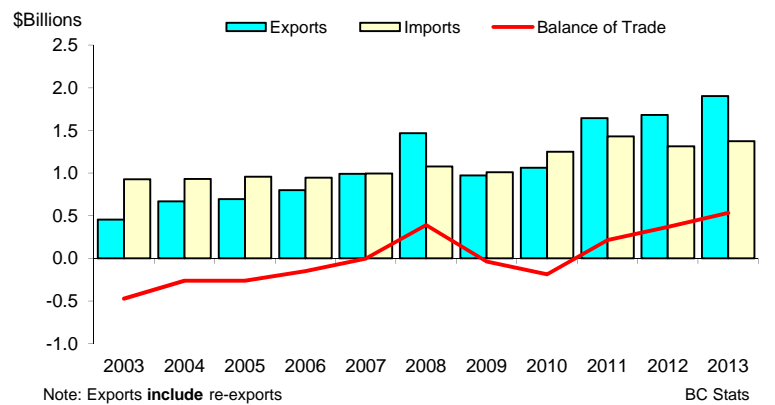

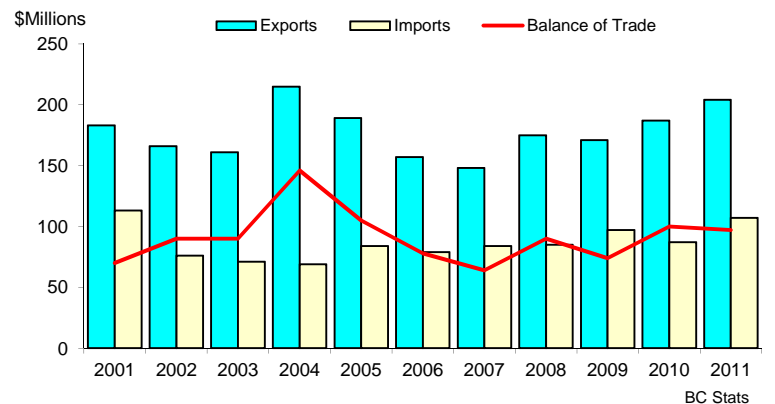
BC Origin Exports to Indonesia

How important is Indonesia to BC and Canada?

Indonesia ranked #15 as a destination for BC origin exports in 2013 with 0.4% of BC's commodity exports shipped there. It was ranked #16 as a destination for Canadian exports with 0.4% of Canadian goods exports shipped there and #34 as a source of imports into Canada with 0.3% of Canadian imports originating from Indonesia.

How important is Canada to Indonesia?

Canada was the source of approximately 0.5% of imports into Indonesia in 2012. Approximately 0.6% of exports from Indonesia were destined for Canada in that year.

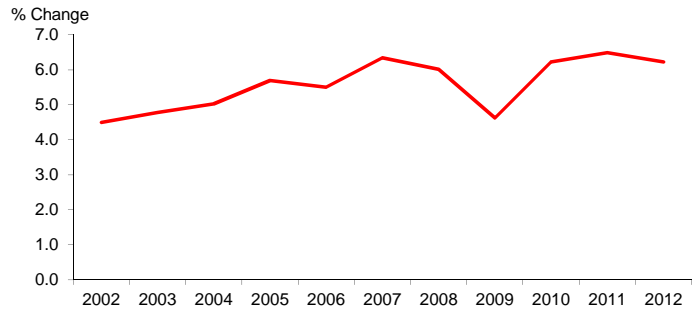

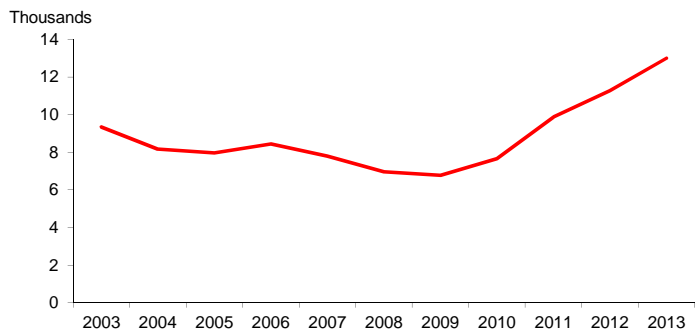
Immigrants to BC from Indonesia
