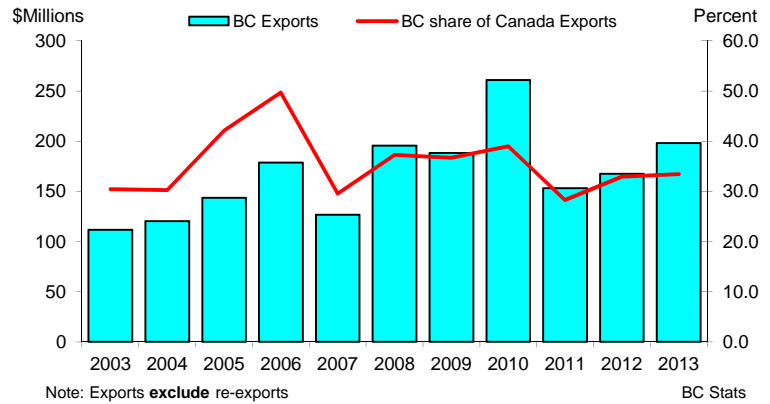

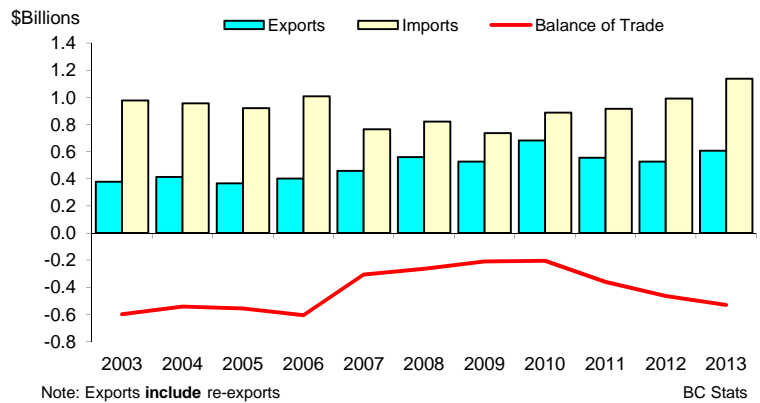
BC Origin Exports to Philippines

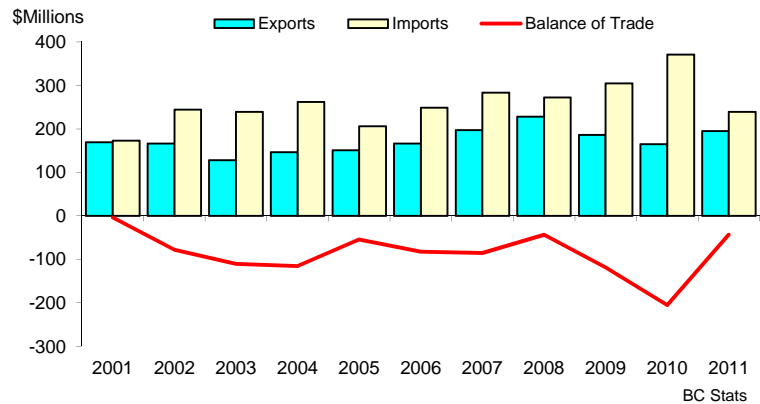
Canada's Balance of Trade in Goods with Philippines

How important is Philippines to BC and Canada?

Philippines ranked #13 as a destination for BC origin exports in 2013 with 0.6% of BC's commodity exports shipped there. It was ranked #32 as a destination for Canadian exports with 0.1% of Canadian goods exports shipped there and #41 as a source of imports into Canada with 0.2% of Canadian imports originating from Philippines.

How important is Canada to Philippines?

Canada was the source of approximately 1.0% of imports into Philippines in 2012. Approximately 1.7% of exports from Philippines were destined for Canada in that year.

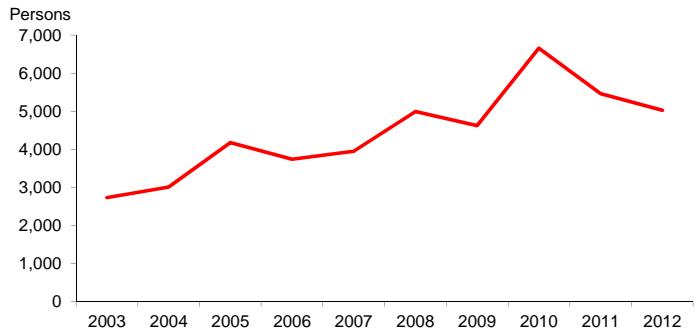
Year-Over-Year % Growth in GDP of Philippines

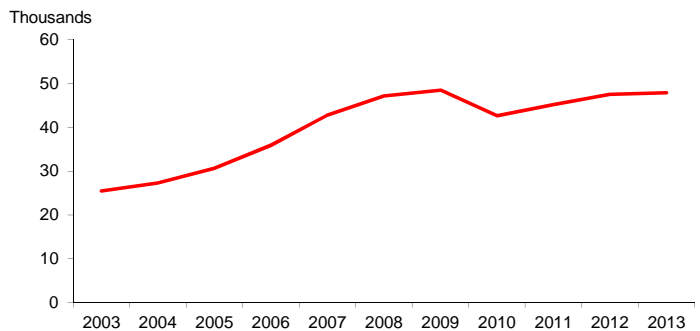
Immigrants to BC from Philippines
