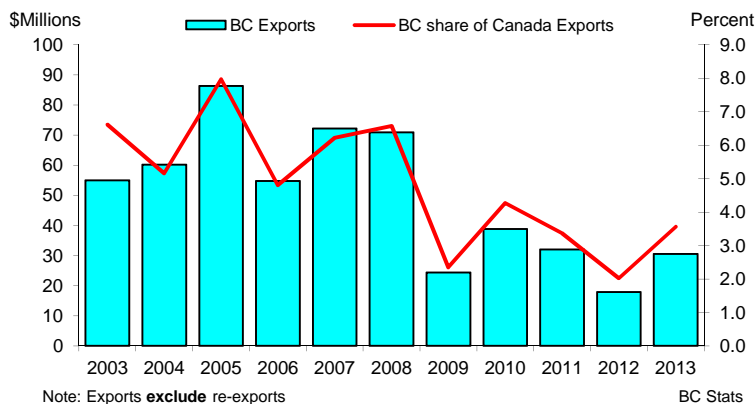

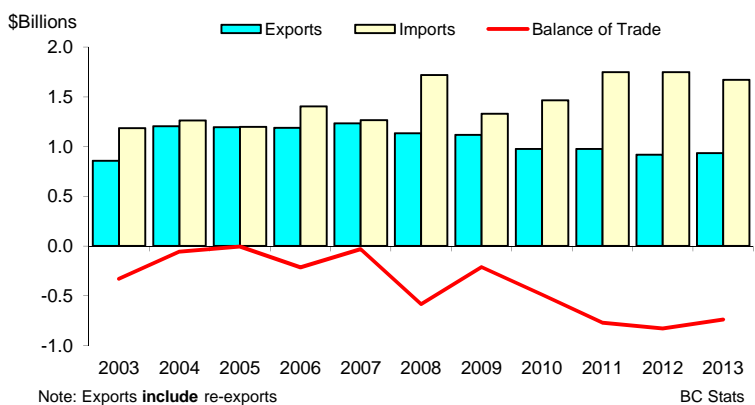
BC Origin Exports to Spain

How important is Spain to BC and Canada?

Spain ranked #36 as a destination for BC origin exports in 2013 with 0.1% of BC's commodity exports shipped there. It was ranked #24 as a destination for Canadian exports with 0.2% of Canadian goods exports shipped there and #30 as a source of imports into Canada with 0.4% of Canadian imports originating from Spain.

How important is Canada to Spain?

Canada was the source of approximately 0.3% of imports into Spain in 2012. Approximately 0.5% of exports from Spain were destined for Canada in that year.

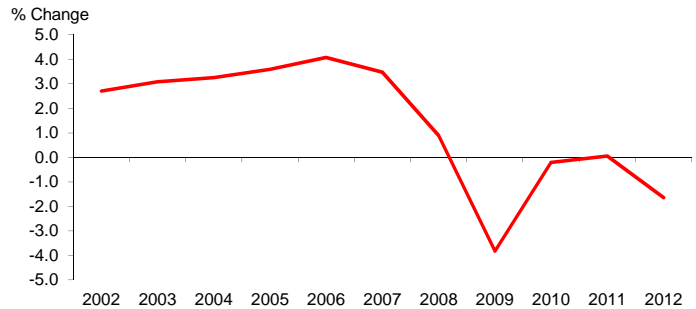

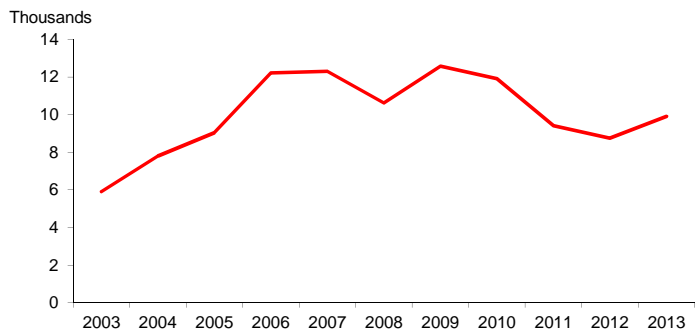
Immigrants to BC from Spain
