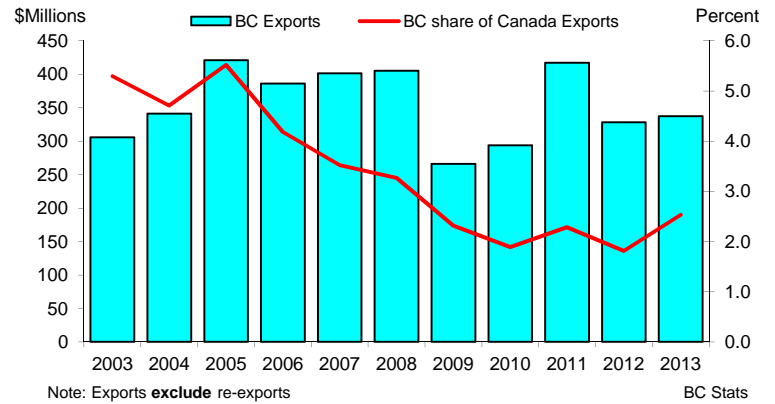

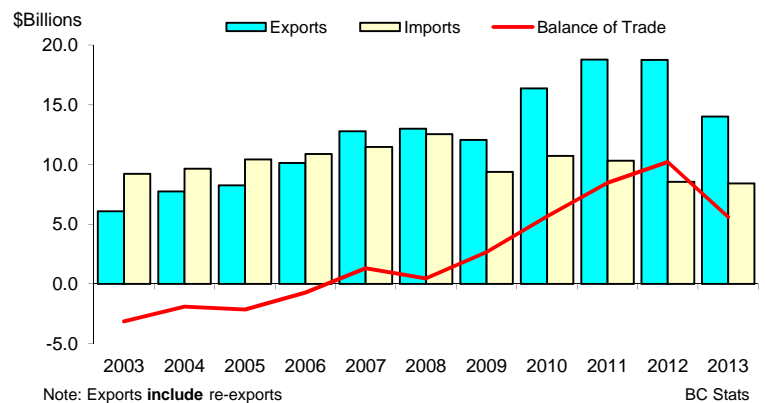
BC Origin Exports to United Kingdom

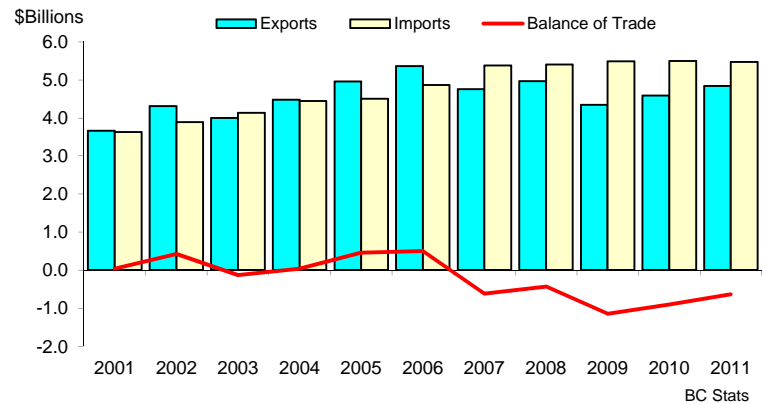
Canada's Balance of Trade in Goods with United Kingdom

How important is United Kingdom to BC and Canada?

United Kingdom ranked #7 as a destination for BC origin exports in 2013 with 1.0% of BC's commodity exports shipped there. It was ranked #3 as a destination for Canadian exports with 3.0% of Canadian goods exports shipped there and #6 as a source of imports into Canada with 1.8% of Canadian imports originating from United Kingdom.

How important is Canada to United Kingdom?

Canada was the source of approximately 2.2% of imports into United Kingdom in 2012. Approximately 2.2% of exports from United Kingdom were destined for Canada in that year.

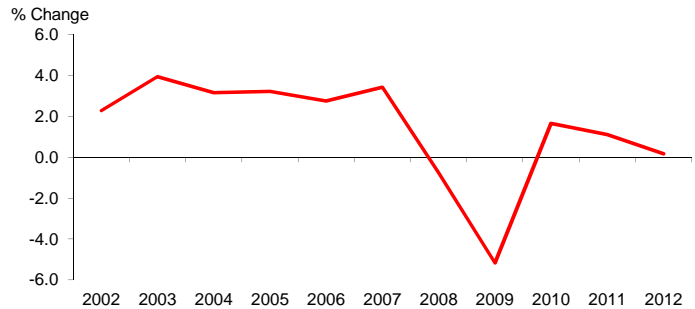

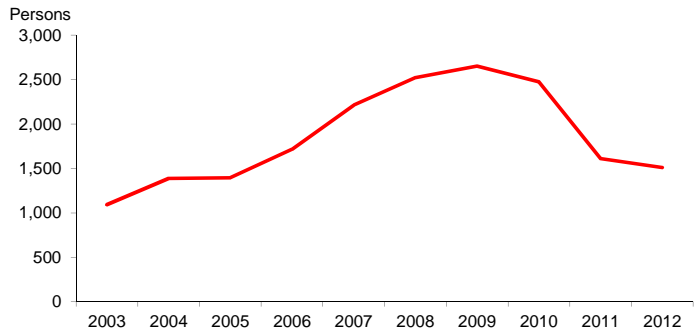
Year-Over-Year % Growth in GDP of United Kingdom

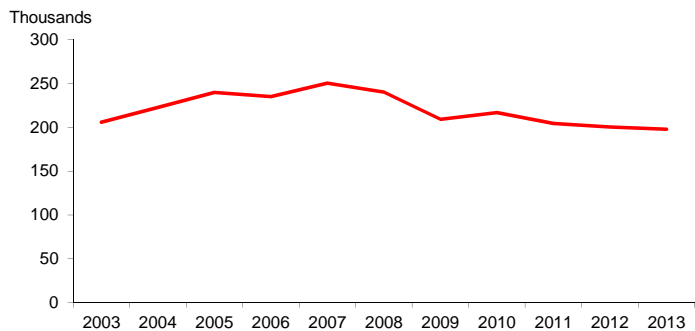
Immigrants to BC from United Kingdom
