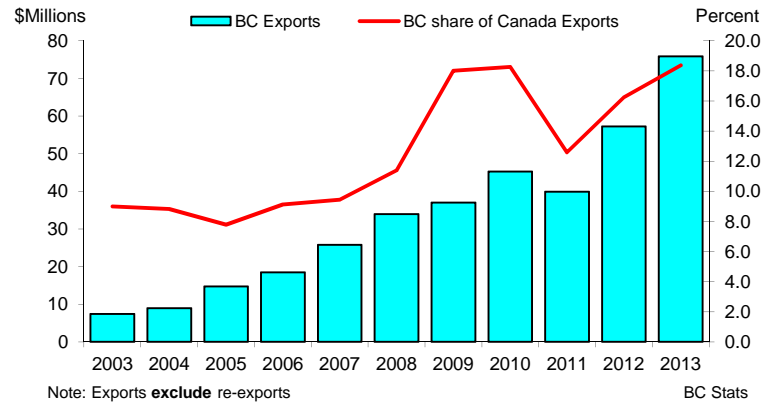

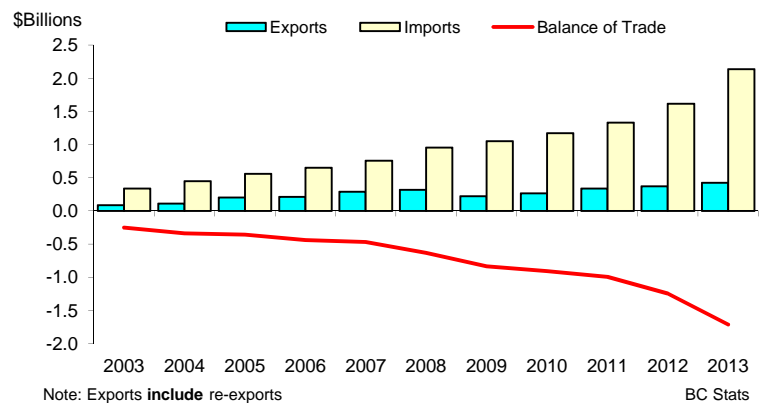

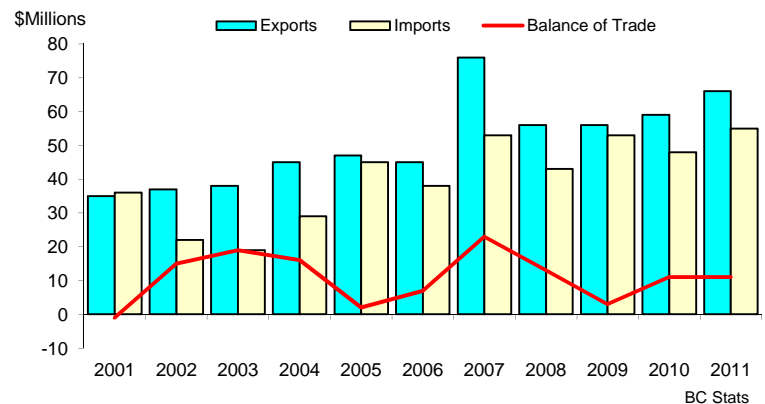
BC Origin Exports to Vietnam

How important is Vietnam to BC and Canada?

Vietnam ranked #23 as a destination for BC origin exports in 2013 with 0.2% of BC's commodity exports shipped there. It was ranked #39 as a destination for Canadian exports with 0.1% of Canadian goods exports shipped there and #24 as a source of imports into Canada with 0.5% of Canadian imports originating from Vietnam.

How important is Canada to Vietnam?

Canada was the source of approximately 0.2% of imports into Vietnam in 2012. Approximately 0.9% of exports from Vietnam were destined for Canada in that year.

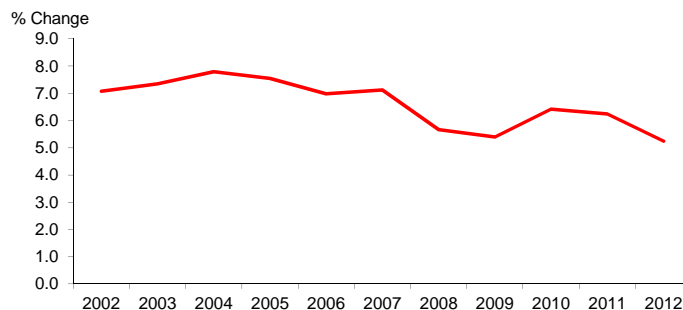

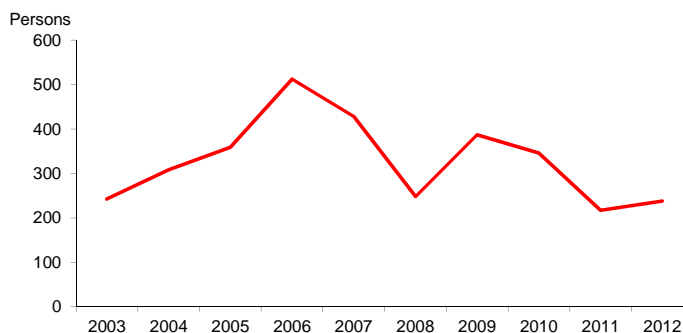
Year-Over-Year % Growth in GDP of Vietnam

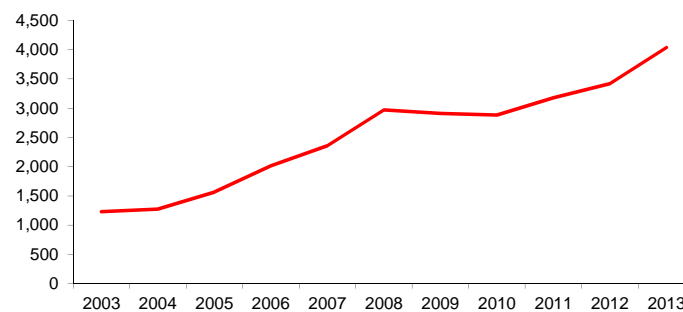
Immigrants to BC from Vietnam
