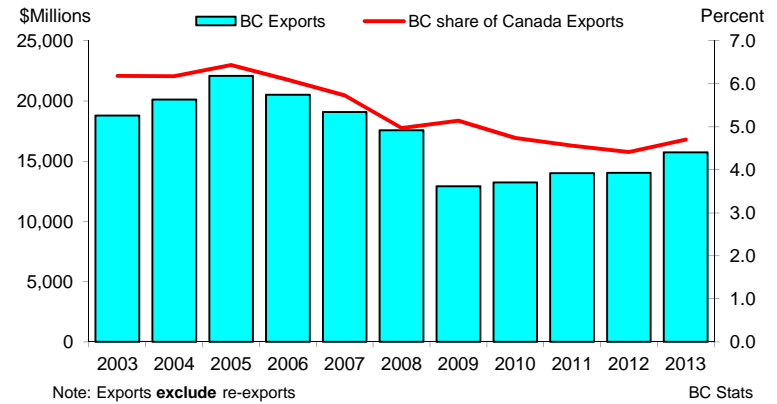

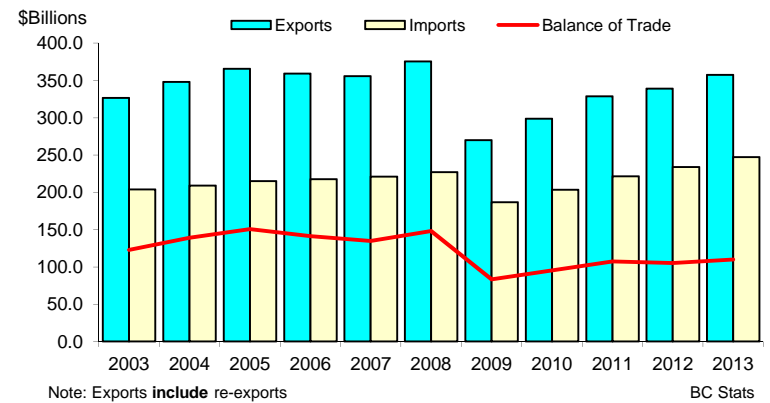

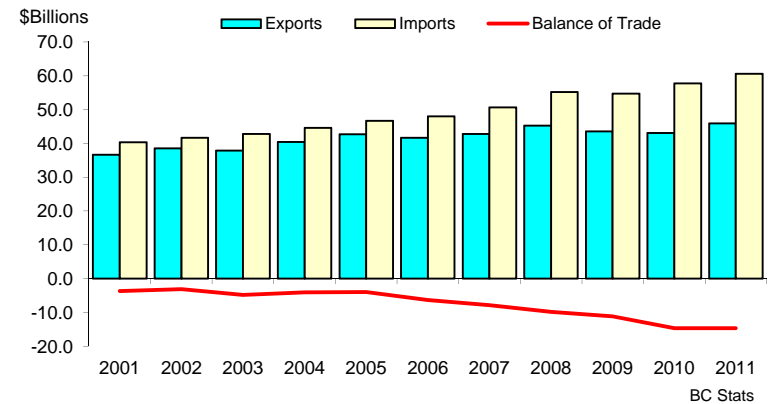
## BC Origin Exports to United States

### How important is United States to BC and Canada?

United States ranked #1 as a destination for BC origin exports in 2013 with 46.8% of BC's commodity exports shipped there. It was ranked #1 as a destination for Canadian exports with 75.5% of Canadian goods exports shipped there and #1 as a source of imports into Canada with 52.1% of Canadian imports originating from United States.

### How important is Canada to United States?

Canada was the source of approximately 14.6% of imports into United States in 2013. Approximately 19.7% of exports from United States were destined for Canada in that year.

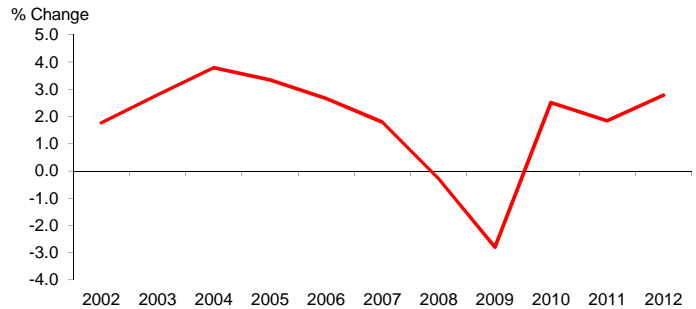

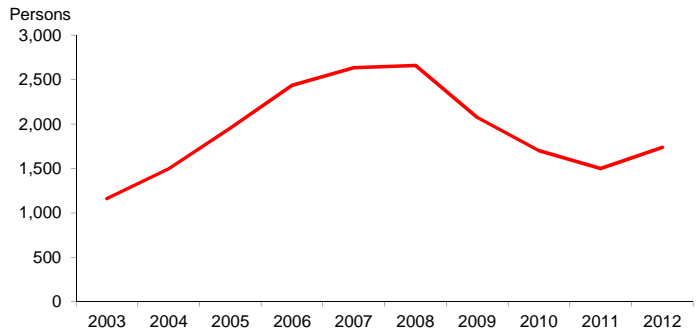
### Year-Over-Year % Growth in GDP of United States

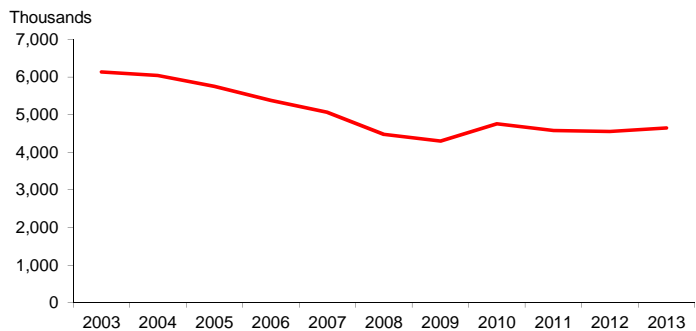
### Immigrants to BC from United States
