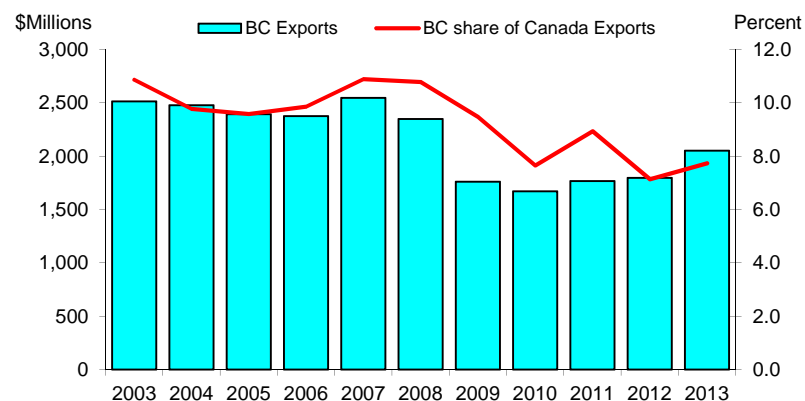

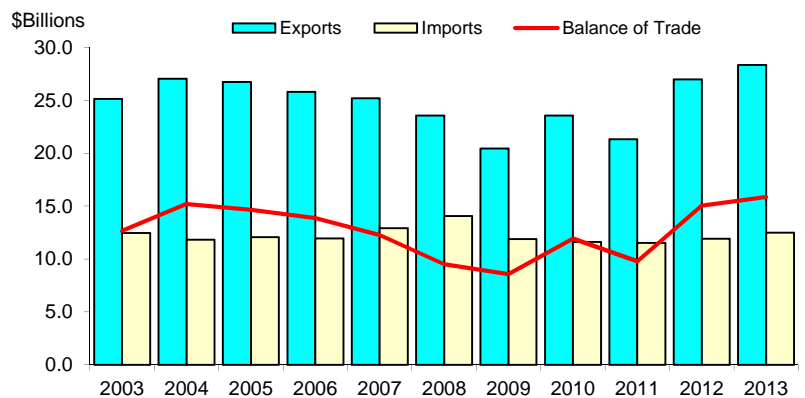
BC Origin Exports to California

How does California compare with other US states?

Among the states, California ranked #2 as a destination for BC Exports and #3 as a destination for Canadian Exports. As a source of imports to Canada, it ranked #6 among the states.

How important is California to BC and Canada?

If California were a separate country, it would rank #4 as a destination for BC origin exports in 2013 with 6.1% of BC's commodity exports shipped there. It would be ranked #2 as a destination for Canadian exports with 6.0% of Canadian goods exports shipped there and #6 as a source of imports into Canada with 2.6% of Canadian imports originating from California.

California Travel to Canada

There were 783,000 trips made by residents of California to Canada in 2012 and they spent \$Cdn 593 million while visiting. California ranked #4 among the states in terms of the number of residents making trips to Canada.

Canadian Travel to California

The number of trips by Canadians to California in 2012 was 1,543,000. The total amount spent on those trips was \$Cdn 1506 million. California ranked #6 among the states as a destination for Canadian travellers.

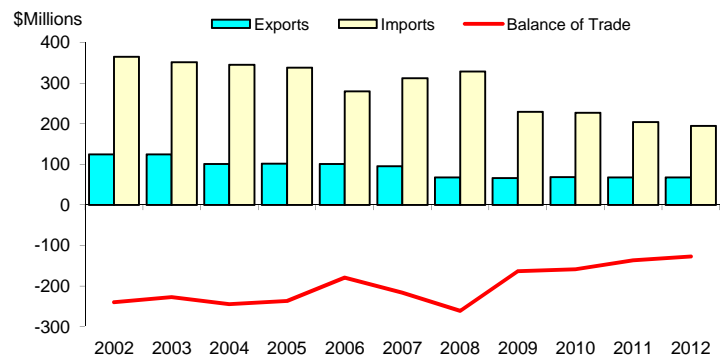
Year-Over-Year % Growth in GDP of California
