**AMENDMENT #8  
TO CERTIFICATE #E13-01**

**WHEREAS:**

- A. On January 8, 2013, Creek Power Inc. was issued Certificate #E13-01 (Certificate) respecting the Project;
- B. On August 8, 2013, Amendment #1 provided for the transfer of the Certificate and all of Creek Power Inc.'s interest in the Project to the Upper Lillooet River Power Limited Partnership, Boulder Creek Power Limited Partnership, and North Creek Hydro Power Limited Partnership (collectively, the "Holders");
- C. On November 21, 2017, the Holders submitted an application to amend the Certificate to remove a requirement to install and operate a signaling system to warn the public of potentially dangerous flow releases and to inform the public of how to respond to the signals; and
- D. The Executive Director has delegated his power under section 19(3) and (4) of the Act to the undersigned, and the undersigned has considered the application.

**NOW THEREFORE:**

I amend the first paragraph of Condition #35 of Schedule B of Certificate #E13-01 as follows:

Prior to operations, the Holders must install signage to the satisfaction of the EAO to warn users of the Pebble Creek Hot Springs of potential hazards from flow changes caused by the operation of the project. The number, content, size, format and locations of the signage must be consistent with the Canadian Dam Association Technical Bulletin Signage for Public Safety around Dams (2011 or as amended or replaced from time

to time) unless otherwise authorized by the EAO. The signage must be in place for the duration of operations.

The second paragraph of Condition #35 is unchanged.
