The information in this list is based on the Statements of Votes, the Journals, the binder containing records of by-elections, the binder containing election histories of electoral districts, and Legislative Library Reference Files.

Elections in British Columbia before 1903 were not held along party lines and the Statements of Votes do not refer to party affiliation for all ridings until 1933. As a result, information on party affiliation is either nonexistent or suspect for many members before 1933. If the party affiliation is not stated in one of the sources mentioned above, it is not included in this work. If a member changed his or her party affiliation, this is indicated when known. In the early years by-elections were required to allow the voters of an electoral district to approve of the appointment of their member to a cabinet position and this is indicated when known. This practice ceased in 1929.

If a member did not sit out his full term of office, the date of resignation and reason, or the fact that he or she died are/is stated if the information is available. The birth and death dates which are included should be taken as approximate as these are often difficult to verify.

The form of name of the electoral districts is that given in the statutes. Nicknames which were commonly used have been included in quotations and parentheses after the legal given names. If a member is/was known by a given name other than his or her first name, that name is underlined. Maiden names are given in parentheses after given names. If a member became Premier or Speaker, that fact is indicated.
