## CLARK CABINET

### INTRODUCTION

Glen Clark was elected leader of the New Democratic Party of British Columbia on February 18, 1996 and was sworn in as Premier February 22, 1996, taking over from Michael Harcourt. He was first elected to the Legislative Assembly in the general election of October 22, 1986, while the New Democratic Party was still in Opposition. He served in the Harcourt cabinet between 1991-1996 as Minister of Finance and Corporate Relations and then as Minister of Employment and Investment. The New Democratic Party of British Columbia was re-elected under Clark's leadership in the general election May 28, 1996. The first session of the 36th parliament opened June 25, 1996.

The choice of dates for the commencement and termination of a position is not straightforward because an announcement may occur on one date and be confirmed officially on a different date. Generally the "official" date has been used in this document, with footnoted references to any other date(s) involved. If, there was no Order in Council (OIC) or other official notice specifically naming the minister involved, the announcement date has been used.

Mr. Clark announced his resignation as NDP party leader and Premier on August 21, 1999. For the purposes of this document, the final date of service for cabinet ministers in the Clark administration is August 25, 1999 - the date Mr. Clark's successor, Dan Miller, was sworn in as Premier.
