



Oak Bay-Gordon Head RECALL PETITION KNOW THE RULES

**If you plan to participate in the recall campaign,
it's important that you know the rules.**

- The *Recall and Initiative Act* allows registered voters to petition to remove a Member of the Legislative Assembly from office between elections
- On Monday, December 6, 2010 petition sheets will be issued to proponent Michael Roy Hayes to recall the Honourable Ida Chong, Member of the Legislative Assembly (MLA) for the Oak Bay-Gordon Head electoral district
- The proponent has 60 days to collect signatures from more than 40% of the voters who were registered to vote in the Oak Bay-Gordon Head electoral district at the May 12, 2009 General Election, and who are currently registered as voters in B.C.
- The petition must be submitted to Elections BC by 4:30 p.m. Friday, February 4, 2011
- An individual may only sign a recall petition once
- Only registered canvassers may collect signatures and must be volunteers
- Recall advertising may only be conducted by the proponent, MLA or registered advertising sponsors



Elections BC is a non-partisan Office of the Legislature
responsible for administering the *Election Act*, the *Recall and Initiative Act*,
and the conduct of referenda under the *Referendum Act*.
