Deputy Chair, Committee of the Whole

The role of the Committee of the Whole is to provide a final opportunity for Members to ask questions in the final stages of a bill (committee stage) before it is put to an official vote in the Legislature. At the beginning of every parliamentary session, the House appoints an Member to serve as Deputy Chair of the Committee of the Whole. This practice began in British Columbia during the 3rd Session of the 33rd Parliament (1985) with the appointment of Angus Ree. Appointment dates are sourced from the *Journals of the Legislative Assembly of British Columbia*.
